GamCare	<ul> <li>Visit www.gamcare.org.uk where you will find the live chat option available and be able to speak to a trained advisor who can help complete referrals and gain access to women's only services.</li> <li>You can ring the National Gambling Helpline for free on 08088020133, where you will be connected with a trained advisor who can complete referral forms for you and help you to access women's only services.</li> <li>You can register on the GamCare website to access the women's only chatroom which runs every Saturday 6:30pm-7:30pm.</li> </ul>	Professionals can direct their service users to the GamCare website and encourage them to self-refer via the chat system or by providing them with the National Gambling Helpline number on 08088020133.
